Speakers Meeting - Carol Hogard

The speaker for March will be Carol Hogard. She will be presenting information on a paper published by Claudia Goldin entitled "Jumping the Barriers: A Hundred Years of Women's Progress Toward the Dream of Equity in Careers, Marriage and Childcare," based on the research of 2023 Nobel Laureate in Economics, Claudia Goldin.

Examining the aspirations and choices of five groups of notable college-educated women from 1887-2000, she constructs a history of the economic contributions of each group, the barriers they faced, the cultural and technological changes that aided them in their struggle.

Finally, she defines the most pressing current barriers and presents ideas for remediation.
